

Crested Butte Real Estate Update

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As we approach what many locals consider to be the most exciting time of year – summer - it's time to reflect on how the real estate market is doing. It's a question many realtors are frequently asked. Most realtors would love to say that real estate is doing "awesome", and many may be tempted to report just that. Some may declare that it is a "Buyers" market or a "Sellers" market. However, we look at the statistics to tell us what is happening in Crested Butte area real estate. This is an update to our twice yearly report on the different sectors of the Crested Butte real estate market.

As of May 1, 2026, there were 38 properties under contract representing another \$71,440,300 in potential sales dollars for the year.

Total sales dollars and volume of transactions slightly increased in 2025, over 2024, and demand for real estate remains very robust as we head into summer 2026. Our inventory levels remain low throughout the area. Many new and exciting building projects and homes are in the works in the valley which continues to keep builders and developers very busy. Real Estate prices should continue to remain strong this year in Crested Butte.
